DID YOU KNOW? One in 40 Ashkenazi Jewish men and women carries a BRCA mutation which can lead to a higher risk of breast, ovarian, pancreatic, prostate, and other cancers. There is also a 50% chance of passing this mutation on to the next generation regardless of family history.

IF YOU KNOW, there are proactive measures you can take to mitigate these risks and significantly reduce your chance of developing cancer or identify it at its earliest, most treatable stages.
